Grant Ready Check List



☐ Research	Have you researched grant opportunities that align with your mission and programs?
☐ Eligibility	Have you reviewed each grant's guidelines to confirm your organization is eligible?
☐ Clear Mission & Vision	Do you have clear mission and vision statements (who you serve, what you do, how you do it)?
☐ Staff Capacity	Does your team have time and expertise to meet reporting requirements?
☐ Impact & Reputation	Can you show that your programs make a measurable difference and that your organization has community support?
☐ Resources & Infrastructure	Do you have the tools, systems, and staff in place to manage new grants (grant writer, database, tracking)?
☐ Sustainability	Do you have a plan to continue your

	project once grant funding ends?
☐ Financial Health	Are your financial records accurate, audited, and grant-ready?
☐ Budget Preparedness	Do you have a detailed, realistic budget that matches the grant's guidelines?
☐ Board Engagement	Is your board actively engaged and supportive of your fundraising and grant-seeking efforts?
☐ Strategic Alignment	Are your grant-seeking efforts tied to your strategic plan and long-term goals?
☐ Data & Evaluation	Do you have systems in place to collect data and evaluate program impact?

If you checked most or all of these boxes, you're ready to begin applying for grants. If not, use this checklist as your roadmap to get prepared before you start submitting proposals.

Consider a <u>GRANT READINESS ASSESSMENT</u> to identify gaps in your nonprofit's documents, systems, and strategy so you know exactly what to fix to be fully prepared for funding opportunities.
